

GCSE/IGCSE Exams: Years 10 and 11



What is Key Stage 4 (KS4)?


Key Stage 4 (KS4) covers students aged 14 to 16, most typically in Years 10 and 11.

At the end of KS4, students take GCSE (General Certificate of Secondary Education) or IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) exams.

What are GCSE & IGCSE?

- GCSEs are UK qualifications assessed through exams & coursework.
- IGCSEs are similar but internationally recognized and often exam-based.
- Both lead to A-Levels or IBDP courses in Sixth Form (Years 12-13).

How Are GCSE/IGCSEs Graded?

- GCSEs use a 9-1 grading scale (9 = highest, 1 = lowest).
- IGCSEs may use A-G or 9-1, depending on the exam hoard.
- Pass Grade: Grade 4 or above is a "standard pass".

Subject Selections

All students at Charterhouse Lagos are required to study a core curriculum comprising:

- English Language and English Literature (equivalent to two IGCSE qualifications)
- Mathematics
- At least two sciences from: Biology, Chemistry, and Physics

In addition to these core subjects, students will select three or four additional subjects, depending on their interests, strengths, and future aspirations.

This structure is designed to ensure a balanced and challenging academic profile, leading to a total of eight or nine IGCSE qualifications by the end of Year 11.

- Help establish a study plan -Encourage a balanced revision routine.
- Provide access to learning resources Use past papers, guides, and online tools.
