

Introducing our purpose-built boarding facilities: Toddites House for boys and Hencherites House for girls. Designed for modern living, these houses provide a safe, secure, supportive, and enriching environment that fosters personal growth, academic success, and lifelong friendships and connections.

Accommodation

Each room houses up to four students, balancing community and personal space.

- Comfortable: High-quality beds, study desks, and ample storage.
- Climate-Controlled: Air-conditioned for year-round comfort.
- Ensuite Bathrooms: Private, practical, and included in every room.

Facilities

- TV and Relaxation Room: Equipped with large comfortable seating and a foosball table, providing a space for students to unwind. This complements the Rotunda, a separate area designed for calm and peaceful relaxation.
- Computer & Gaming Room: Students can use computers or play on Xbox and PS5, with headphones required to maintain a quiet atmosphere.
- Study/Reading room: a calm, focused area for study, reflection, and independent reading.
- Lounge: a social space with lots of comfy seating.

Student wellbeing:


Charterhouse Lagos prioritises pastoral care and academic excellence.

Yes, students may have devices and mobile phones. They can contact parents during a designated evening period. Social areas also include gaming devices for relaxation.

• How will my child attend church or mosque services if clergy do not visit the campus?

We arrange supervised visits to local churches and mosques. While we aim to support different denominations, we may not always be able to provide access to every specific place of worship.

• What measures are in place to ensure the safety and well-being of students?

Our 24/7 medical centre is staffed by Evercare professionals. Houseparents and Tutors provide daily care, and students can meet with our school counsellor in a private setting when needed or requested.
